Frog Legs and Cross-Cultural Ministry



"I have another perception of life, feeling useful and open." This was one of the takeaways that Gossé (pictured left), a student at the West Africa Bible Institute (IBAO), shared after spending six months as a pastoral intern in a village called Trokpadrou in the western part of Côte d'Ivoire. As IBAO interns came together this spring to share about their internships, Gossé recounted the story of being

stretched and challenged. Although Trokpadrou is only a few hours from Gossé's home village, a few of the dishes eaten there are different. One day, Gossé was served frog, which he was concerned about eating! He remembered, though, that during his time at IBAO, he learned that it is important to identify with the people with

whom you are serving. So Gossé tried the frog, eating one of the legs, and found that it was quite delicious! He also found pounded manioc, also known as cassava, to be a dish that was eaten in Trokpadrou that was not what he was used to. Gossé faced other challenges during his internship as well, but by the end, he said that he learned that he was useful. "Before, I found that I was unuseful because I didn't have money," he shared. "But after the internship, I learned that I can help people even without money." Sharing



courageously and deeping his faith in God are other ways that Gossé has grown, saying, "IBAO has given me an identity."

Pastoral intern Mayala (pictured right) split his period of internship between two

locations: a new church plant and an established congregation. He stated that his internship was an opportunity to be "with the family of God to learn."

We were grateful to have the interns over to our house *(pictured left)* one last time before we celebrate graduation together on May 27. Pray for these servants of God to continue to be led by the Holy Spirit and to have strong, frutiful ministries!
